Vale 4th of July Wild Cow Milking Rules

- 1. Two loops can be thrown
- 2. Roper begins on horse and remains the roper through the whole event.
- 3. Mugger starts on the ground and remains the mugger through the whole event.
- 4. Cow can ONLY be milked by the ROPER.
- 5. Roper must dally and rope will not be tied hard and fast.
- 6. Clean head catch around the neck.
- 7. Cow must be legally roped and standing on ALL 4 hooves while milked.
- 8. Rope has to be completely off the cow (OFF meaning that the rope is completely off and not touching the cow) before Roper/Milker enters the circle.
- 9. Judge must have stop watch and allow 5 seconds for milk to drip from the bottle.

YOU WILL BE DISQUALIFIED IF:

- 1. The above rules are not followed.
- 2. Holding cow by the tail to stop or slow her down.
- 3. Exceeding 2 minute time limit.
- 4. If rope is not free of horse and saddle when Roper comes in contact with cow.
